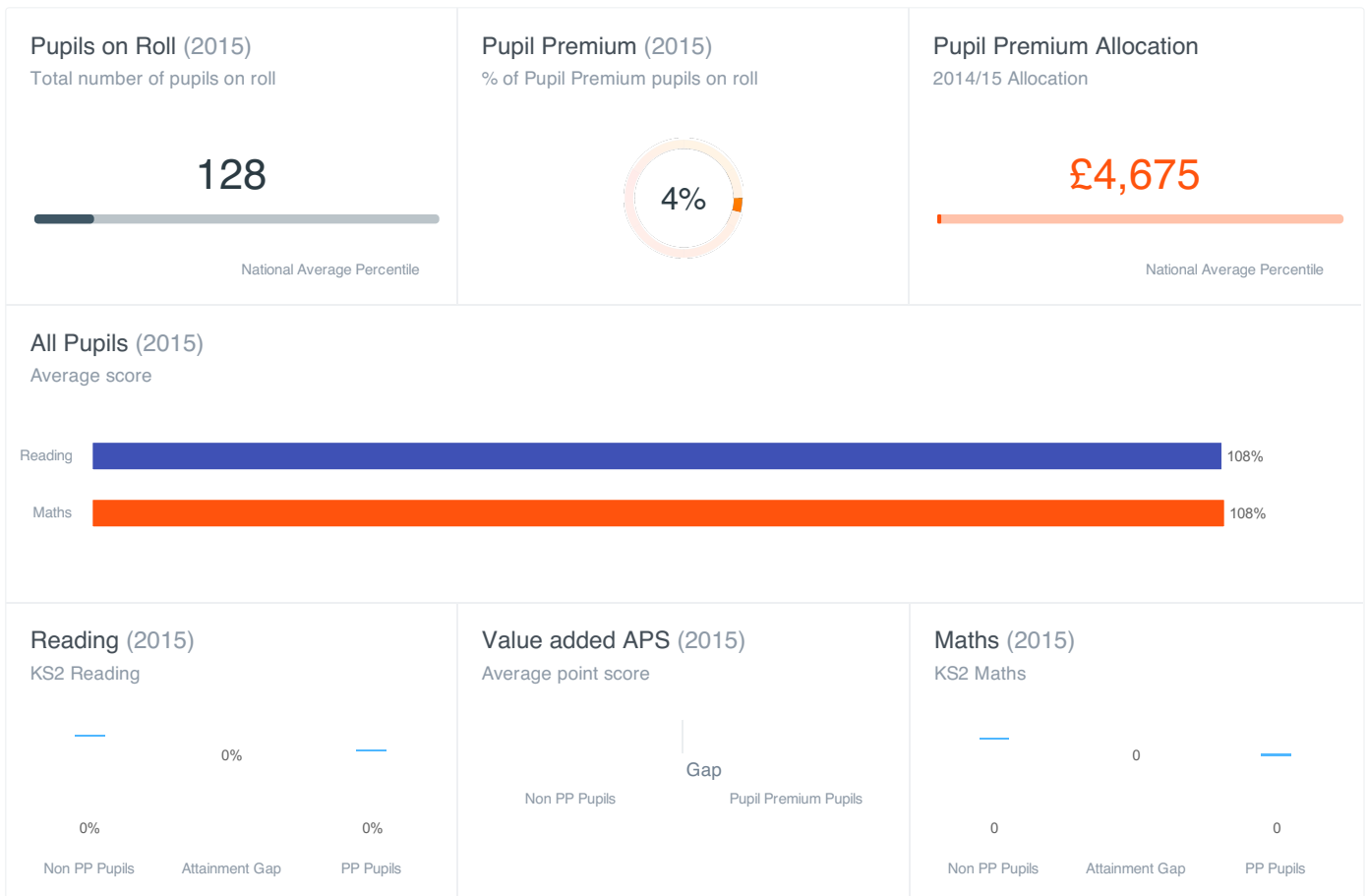


Our Lady Catholic Primary School

Our Lady Catholic Primary School is placed in a family of similar schools, according to the characteristics of your pupils. The prior attainment of pupils, the percentage eligible for Pupil Premium, and the proportion with English as an additional language are all considered in grouping the families.

Attainment in your Family of Schools

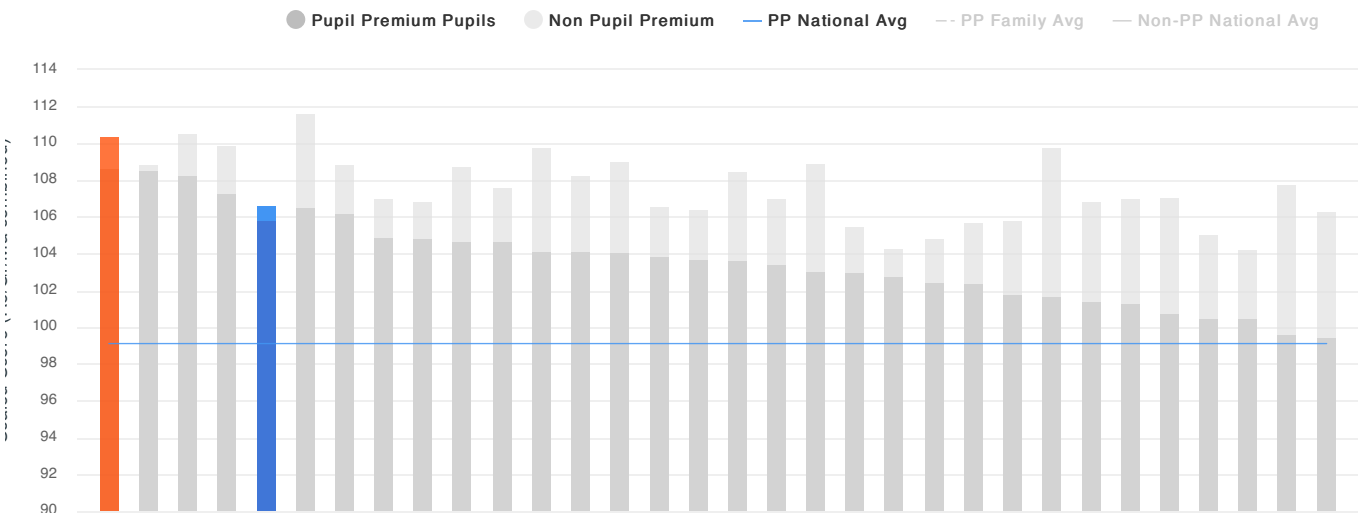
The graph shows the most similar schools to you, based on the characteristics of your pupil intake. The orange bar is your school and the blue bar is your nearest statistical neighbour, calculated as the most similar school. The key data for your nearest neighbour is presented in the comparison table below.

The graph automatically presents the APS Fine Grade score, arranged in order of overall performance for Pupil Premium pupils. Using the Chart Options tab, it is possible to change the measure of performance and the order of the data to gain further insight into the attainment gap.

The legend is interactive so that each indicator can be turned on or off.

Your Family of Schools presents the characteristics and performance of your most similar schools.

The figures combine data from 2014, 2015 and 2016, to produce an overall three year average. The national average line for Pupil Premium pupils is shown automatically.
